Position Title: Forestry Technician

General Description:

Under the supervision of the Forestry Program Manager, the Forestry Technician is responsible for assisting the Forest Stewardship Specialist in planning and implementing all Forest Stewardship Program activities and projects for the communities and forests of American Samoa. The employee must demonstrate the capacity to improve forest stewardship techniques, implement sustainable management practices, and be physically fit to serve landowner clients while maintaining partnerships with various forest landowners and partners.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Assist with all Forestry Stewardship Program activities
- Develop files and contracts for each forest landowner partner to enhance existing and potential collaboration between the Forestry Program and forest stewards
- Conduct forest assessments and follow-ups to develop forest management plans for program projects sites
- Assist with the maintenance of the Forestry Greenhouse and prepare saplings for outplanting in landowner forest areas
- Must be certified in herbicide and pesticide safety and usage
- Conduct native and coastal tree outplantings that support both the Forest Stewardship and Urban Community Forestry program projects
- Assist the GPS Specialist in compiling all Forestry Program maps and surveys of forest landowner projects
- Assist the program specialist with event planning, presentations, and community activities
- Assist the program specialist in compiling data for nurseries and project sites for Forest Stewardship Program reports
- Be able to utilize and operate Forestry vehicles and office equipment
- Hike steep montane forested areas and carry equipment more than 20+lbs during field work activities
- Work as a team with other Forestry Staff and other ACNR Programs based on the mission and goals of the Division
- Other duties assigned by the Forestry Program Manager
