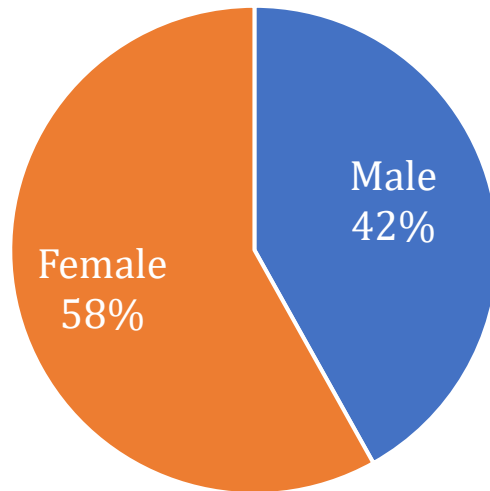
Cohorts

 - Students who enrolled for the first time in Summer and Fall

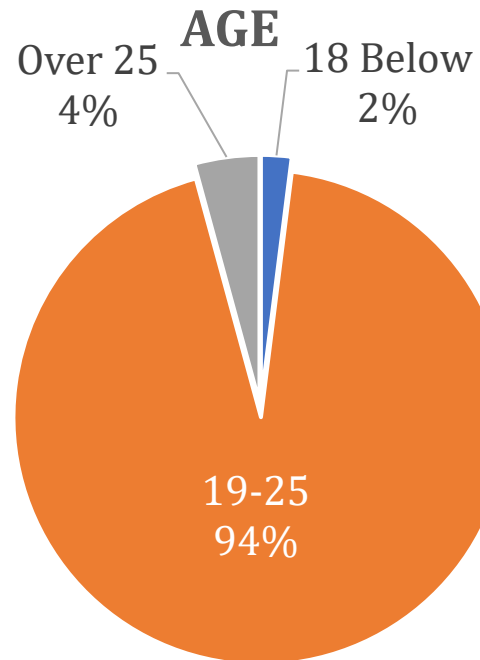


Fall 2020 Cohort Demographics = 401

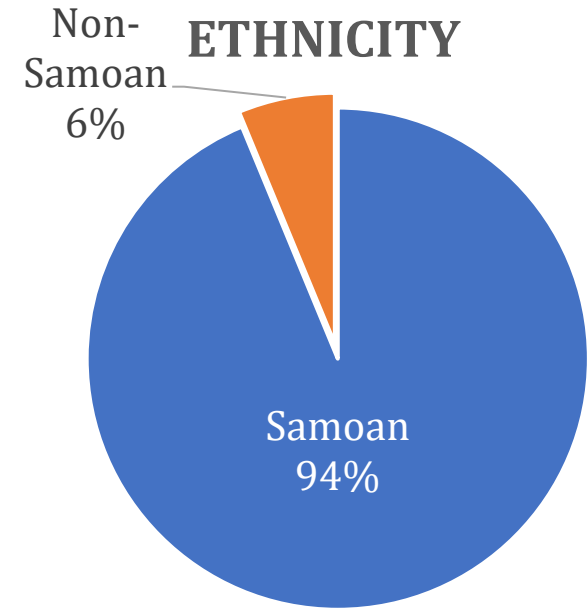

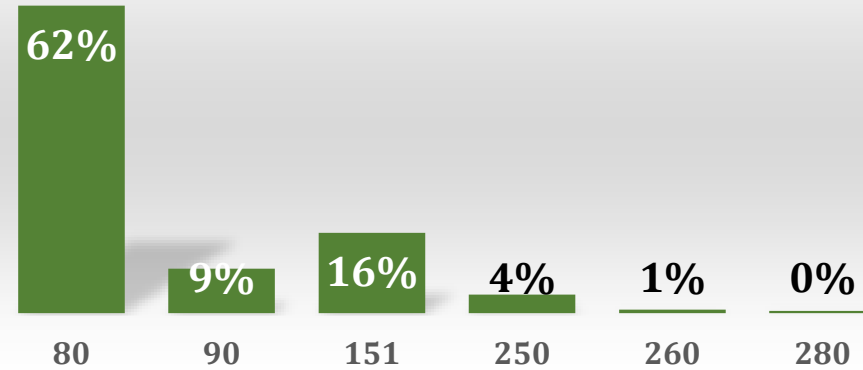


Cohort Placement by Course

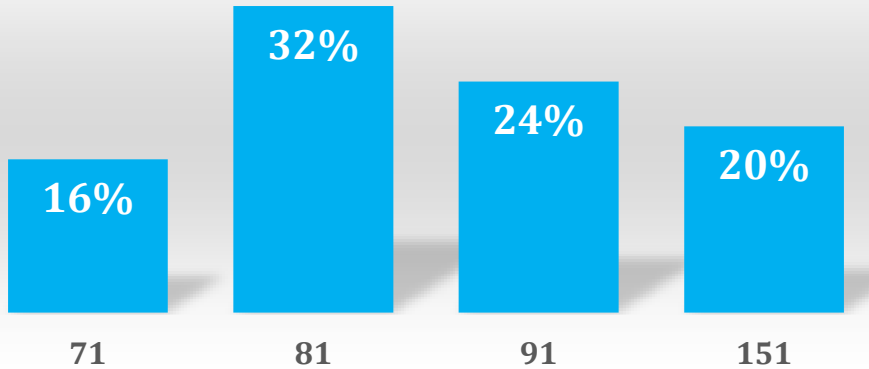

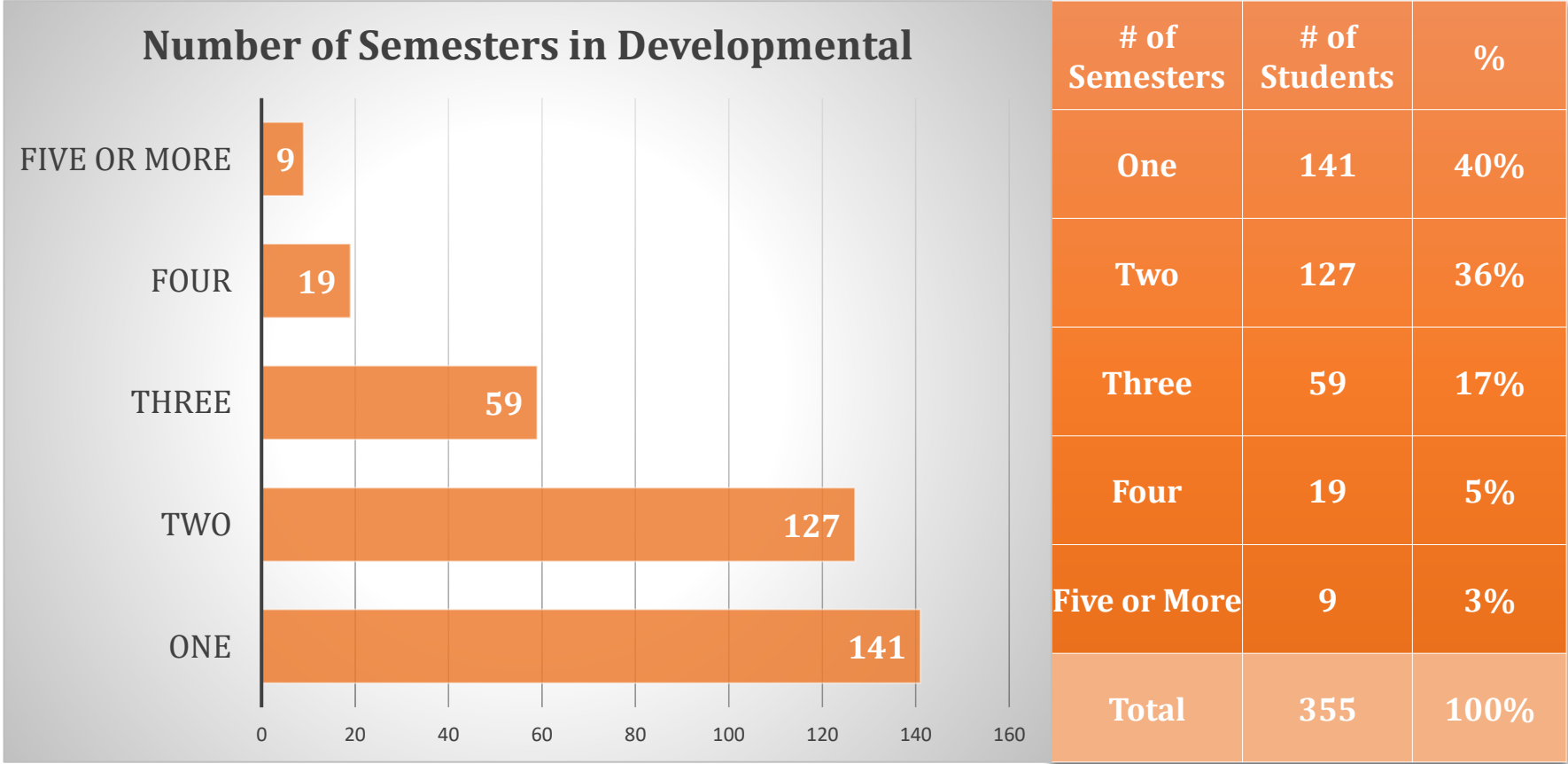

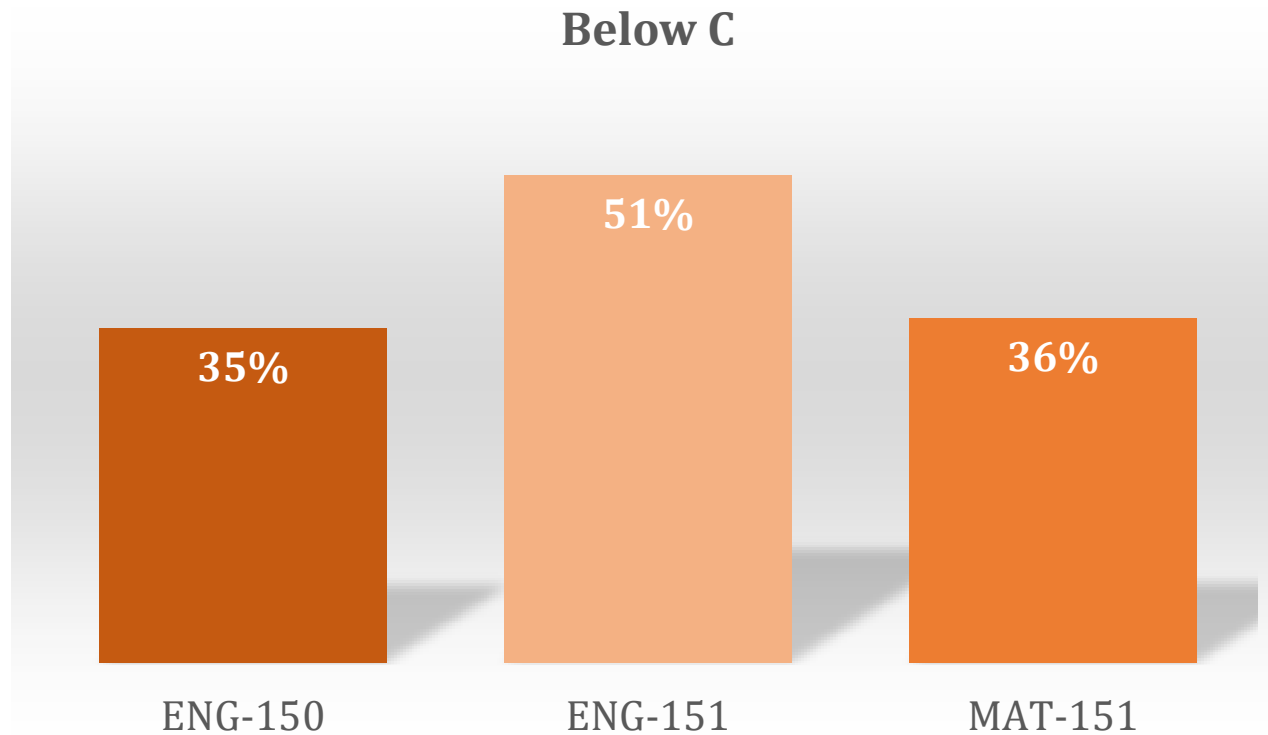

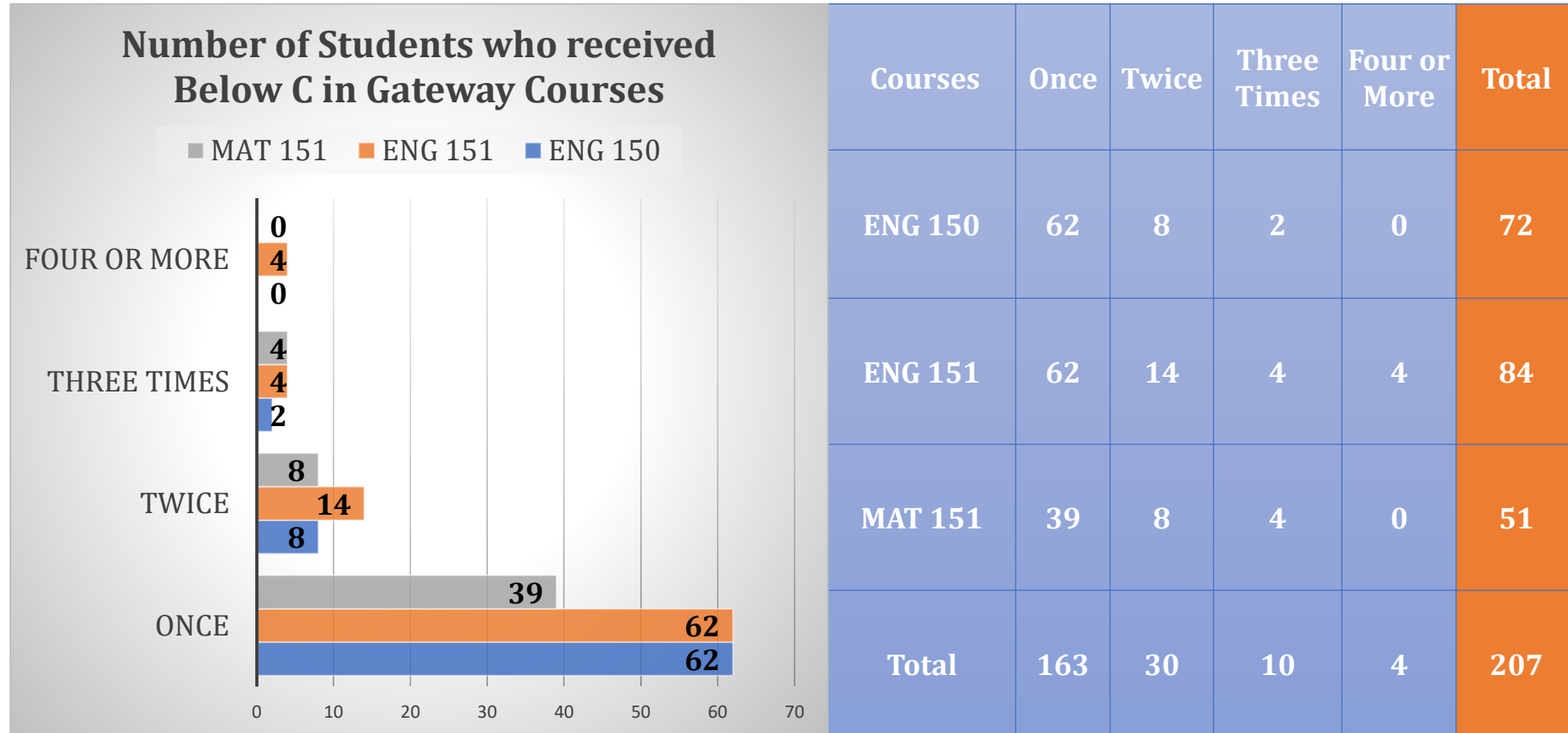
