CATALOG ADDENDUM

<u>Issues/concerns:</u> The 10 week session current deadline for grade submission does not provide faculty with sufficient time to grade students' work and final exams.

Rationale/Justification:

Due to the rigorous of 300 level courses with Practicum components, faculty needs time to dialogue on the grading component for practicum as this involves collaboration amongst assigned faculty for the core content courses. The request to extend the deadline for another week will not impact recording of grades by the Records office.

Recommendation:

Extend deadline for another week to provide faculty with enough time for grading and assessment of students' work. New deadline for the 10 week session to replace the current deadline as noted in the 2016-2018 catalog.
