## **General Description:**

Instructor will report directly to the Academic Chairperson of the Trade and Technical Department (TTD). This department is committed to the offering of Certificates and Associate of Science degrees with instructional programs and courses based on national standards and community input for each field of study. TTD programs are designed to prepare students for entry-level employment and to upgrade and improve current employees' vocational and technical skills.

# Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Prepare a syllabus for each class/course and assist in developing and/or modifying program curriculum
- Teach a full instructional course load of 15 credit hours or 225 instructional contact hours per semester. However, loads may vary between 12 and 16 credit hours per semester
- Observe, monitor and remain in compliance with established safety rules, practices and procedures pertaining to industrial workspaces, comply with all TTD, local and federal environmental and health regulations and policies
- Work as a team with other instructors in developing departmental mission, programs, and courses, and assist in the implementation of departmental projects, under the Director's supervision
- Keep office hours to assist students and serve as their advisor
- Be physically on campus at a minimum of six hours each day of class or as required
- Serve on one or more of ASCC committee, upon approval of the TTD Director
- Work with Advisory Council to align courses with industry standards
- Develop, implement, and assess Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs) for each course taught
- Share SLO data collected from course taught with department and other college stakeholders and provide recommendations for improvement and student learning
- Participate in the different levels of SLO review, program review, and student assessment
- Work with Advisory Council to promote, outreach, and recruit students for the program
- Perform other duties as assigned by TTD Director

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Associate Degree in Electronic Technology. In lieu of a degree, must have seven years of progressive experience in electronics
- Knowledge of skills in and experience with closely related fields
- Current certification and licensure from a U.S. recognized institution in closely related field highly required
